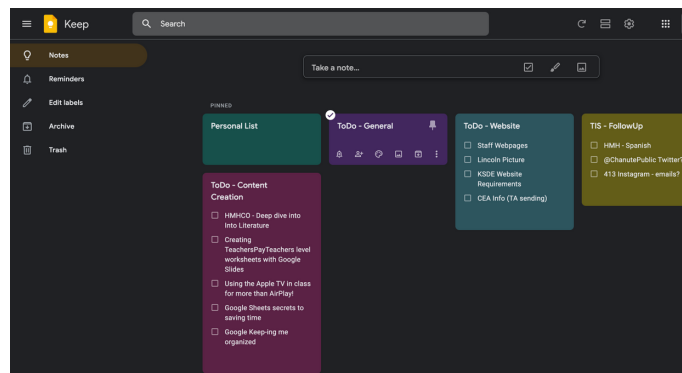
Key features included with Google Keep:

- Reminders/alarms for tasks
- Add collaborators
- Change colors of notes
- Add images to notes
- Archive notes (hides but doesn't delete)
- Label notes for organization
- Notes are searchable
- Add notes to a Google Doc
- Voice to text (app only)
- Add a drawing

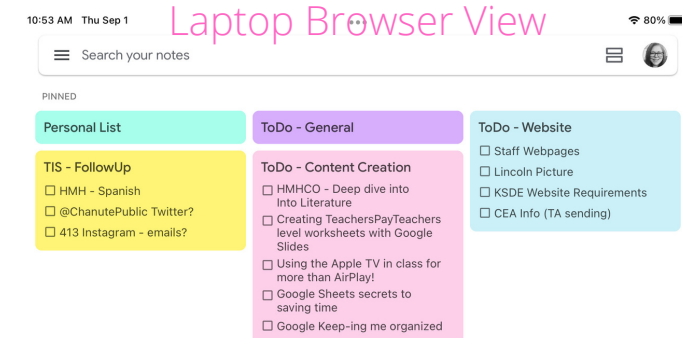


Ways to use it in the classroom:

- Have a note shared with all members of a club so that everyone can track what tasks still need to be completed.
- Students could create one for each class and use it as a planner.
- Teachers can create a checklist and duplicate it so each student gets a clean copy shared with them to track progress through editing or projects.
